BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 12.25 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 12.25.033. GROUNDS FOR ARREST BY PEACE OFFICER WITHOUT

11

WARRANT. A peace officer may arrest a person without a warrant, whether  
12 or not the offense is committed in the presence of the officer, when the  
13 officer has probable cause to believe that the person to be arrested  
14 has committed the crime of operating a motor vehicle in violation of  
15 AS 28.35.030 or a similar city or borough ordinance, if the violation is  
16 alleged to have occurred less than eight hours before the time of arrest.
