6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to retirement; and providing for  
7 an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.25.168 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 14.25.168. MEDICAL BENEFITS. Each person who is entitled to  
11 receive a monthly benefit from the retirement system shall be provided  
12 with major medical insurance coverage. Coverage shall become effective  
13 on the same date as retirement benefits commence and cease when the  
14 retired employee or survivor is no longer eligible to receive a monthly  
15 benefit. The level of coverage for persons over age 65 shall be the  
16 same as that available prior to reaching age 65 except that the benefits  
17 payable shall be supplemental to those afforded under the federal Old  
18 Age Survivor and Disability Insurance Program, if any.

19 \* Sec. 2. AS 39.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

20 Sec. 39.35.535. MEDICAL BENEFITS. Each person who is entitled to  
21 receive a monthly benefit from the retirement system shall be provided  
22 with major medical insurance coverage. Coverage shall become effective  
23 on the same date as retirement benefits commence and cease when the  
24 retired employee or survivor is no longer eligible to receive a monthly  
25 benefit. The level of coverage for persons over age 65 shall be the same  
26 as that available prior to reaching age 65 except that the benefits  
27 payable shall be supplemental to those afforded under the federal Old  
28 Age Survivor and Disability Insurance Program, if any.

1                   (14) "peace officer and fireman" means an employee who is  
2 employed full time in the state as a peace officer, chief of police,  
3 correctional officer, correctional superintendent, fish and game field  
4 biologist and technician , fireman or fire chief;

5 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1975.
