6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to reporting of gunshot and knife
7 wounds; and changing Rule 43(h)(4), Rules of Civil
8 Procedure."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 11.67 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 11.67.011. REPORTING OF GUNSHOT AND KNIFE WOUNDS. (a) A
12 physician treating a person for a gunshot or a knife wound shall report
13 the name of the person treated to the nearest police agency.

14 (b) The report required in (a) of this section shall be made within
15 one hour of rendering treatment for the wound.

16 * Sec. 2. Section 1 of this Act changes Rule 43(h)(4), Rules of Civil
17 Procedure, by requiring a physician to report the name of his patient to a
18 police agency in certain circumstances.
