6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to transfer of voter registration."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 15.07.090(c) is amended to read:

9 (c) The lieutenant governor shall transfer the registration of a
10 voter from one precinct to another within an election district when re-
11 quested by the voter. The request shall be made 30 or more days before
12 the election day. The lieutenant governor shall transfer the registra-
13 tion of a voter from one election district to another when requested by
14 the voter. The voter must reside in his new election district for at
15 least 30 days in order to vote. A voter who has failed to obtain a
16 transfer as provided for in (c) of this section shall vote a "questioned
17 ballot" in his precinct of residence.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 15.07.090(d) is amended to read:

19 (d) A person who claims he is a registered voter, but for whom no
20 evidence of registration in the precinct can be found, shall be granted
21 the right to vote in the same manner as that of a questioned voter and
22 his ballot shall be treated in the same manner. The ballot shall be con-
23 sidered to be a "questioned ballot" and shall be so designated. The
24 lieutenant governor or his representative shall determine whether the
25 voter is registered in the election district before counting the ballot.
26 [A VOTER WHO HAS FAILED TO OBTAIN A TRANSFER AS PROVIDED IN (c) OF THIS
27 SECTION MAY VOTE IN THE PRECINCT WHERE REGISTERED OR HE MAY VOTE A
28 "QUESTIONED BALLOT" IN HIS PRECINCT OF RESIDENCE.]
