6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to eligibility requirements for
7 elective municipal offices."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 29.23.130(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) A borough voter is eligible to be borough mayor. The assembly
11 may by ordinance establish residence requirements for candidates for
12 borough mayor not exceeding three years.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 29.23.200(b) is amended to read:

14 (b) A city voter is eligible to hold [THE] office as a member of
15 the council [OF COUNCILMAN]. The council may by ordinance establish
16 residence requirements for council members not exceeding three years. A
17 council member who ceases to be eligible to be a city voter immediately
18 forfeits that [HIS] office.

19 * Sec. 3. AS 29.23.250(a) is amended to read:

20 (a) A voter of a home rule or general law city is eligible to hold
21 the office of mayor, except that a home rule city may prescribe addi-
22 tional residency requirements by charter. The council, for all other
23 cities, may by ordinance establish residence requirements for candidates
24 for mayor not exceeding three years.
