4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the Alaska Plan Policy Board Commis-
7 sion."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 23 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 12. ALASKA PLAN POLICY BOARD COMMISSION.

11 Sec. 23.12.010. CREATION. There is created in the Office of the
12 Governor the Alaska Plan Policy Board Commission.

13 Sec. 23.12.020. COMPOSITION AND APPOINTMENT. The commission
14 consists of nine commissioners approved by the governor for staggered
15 terms of five years, all as defined in Part IV, sec. (A), Alaska Plan,
16 as approved by the U. S. Department of Labor on March 31, 1972.

17 Sec. 23.12.030. CHAIRMAN AND MEETINGS. (a) The commission shall
18 elect one of its members as chairman.

19 (b) The commission shall hold at least two regular annual meetings
20 and shall hold special meetings as necessary and appropriate.

21 Sec. 23.12.040. REGULATIONS. The commission shall adopt procedura
22 and substantive regulations necessary to implement this chapter.

23 Sec. 23.12.050. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE COMMISSION. The commis-
24 sion shall

25 (1) hire administrative staff as may be necessary to the
26 commission's function;

27 (2) study the problems of minority hire in the state's labor
28 and business community with the purpose of providing direction and
29 assistance in solving minority hire problems;

1 (3) monitor state construction contracts to assure compli-
2 ance with the Alaska Plan, affirmative action commitments under Adminis-
3 trative Order No. 18, November 22, 1972, and other programs and policies
4 designed to maximize minority hire;

5 (4) coordinate recruitment and counseling programs of the
6 Alaska Plan Policy Board;

7 (5) call upon the department and agencies of the state for
8 cooperation and assistance in carrying out this chapter.

9 Sec. 23.12.060. COMPENSATION. The members of the commission are
10 authorized per diem and travel allowances allowable to members of
11 other boards and commissions.

12 Sec. 23.12.070. REPORT TO THE LEGISLATURE. The commission shall,
13 at the beginning of each legislative session, report to the legislature
14 on minority hire problems encountered in the preceding year and may
15 recommend legislative action.
