6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to wage claims; and providing for an  
7 effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 23.05.140(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) If the employment is terminated, regardless of the cause of  
11 termination, all wages, salaries or other compensation for labor or  
12 services become due immediately and shall be paid within 24 hours after  
13 the termination on demand at the place where the employee is usually  
14 paid or at a pay office within the state.

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 23.05.140 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

16 (d) If an employer violates (b) of this section by failing to pay  
17 on demand he is liable to the employee for payment of the employee's  
18 regular wage, salary or other compensation from the time of demand to the  
19 time of payment, or for 90 working days, whichever is the lesser amount.

20 \* Sec. 3. AS 23.05.220(c) is amended to read:

21 (c) The department may not accept an assignment of a claim in  
22 excess of \$5,000 [\$2,500].

23 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10-  
24 070(c).
