6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the taking of predatory animals;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the commissioner
10 of fish and game is authorized, for a 90-day period commencing with the
11 effective date of this Act, to institute and implement a plan for the control
12 of predatory animals, when such action is considered necessary to manage the
13 game resources of the state.

14 * Sec. 2. Within a period of time commencing three months after the
15 effective date of this Act until six months from the effective date of this
16 Act, the Board of Fish and Game shall adopt, in accordance with the Adminis-
17 trative Procedure Act (AS 44.62), comprehensive predator control regulations
18 based on sound biological evidence and in the public interest.

19 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
20 070(c).

21 * Sec. 4. Section 2 of this Act expires six months after the effective
22 date of this Act.
