6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to administration of rehabilitation
7 furloughs; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 33.30.260 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 33.30.260. REHABILITATION FURLOUGHS. The commissioner may
11 authorize a prisoner to participate in educational, training, medical,
12 psychiatric, or other rehabilitation programs approved by the commis-
13 sioner. The commissioner may require that a prisoner participating in
14 these programs has served a minimum of one-third of his sentence before
15 becoming eligible. When the prisoner is not participating in a rehabil-
16 itation program, he shall be confined in the jail unless the commissioner
17 directs otherwise. If the prisoner violates the conditions established
18 for his conduct or custody, the commissioner may order the balance of
19 the prisoner's sentence to be spent in actual confinement. The wilful
20 failure of a prisoner to return to the place of confinement not later
21 than the expiration of any period during which he is authorized to be
22 away from the place of confinement under this section, is an escape from
23 the place of confinement and is punishable under the laws relating to
24 escape.

25 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
26 070(c).
