6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to driver's license re-examination."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 28.15.250(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) The department shall require the re-examination of a licensed
10 operator who is 70 years of age or older. The licensee may be re-
11 examined at the time he renews his license every two years, or as often
12 as the department considers necessary. The re-examination under this
13 subsection shall include a test of the operator's eyesight and a demon-
14 stration of ability to exercise ordinary and reasonable control in the
15 operation of the appropriate vehicle but may not include a test of his
16 ability to read and understand highway signs or his knowledge of the
17 traffic laws of the state.
