6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to driver's license re-examination."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 28.15.250(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) The department shall require the re-examination of a licensed
10 operator who is 76 [70] years of age or older. The licensee may be
11 re-examined at the time he renews his license every two years, or as
12 often as the department considers necessary. The re-examination under
13 this subsection shall include a test of the operator's eyesight and a
14 demonstration of ability to exercise ordinary and reasonable control
15 in the operation of the appropriate vehicle but may not include a test
16 of his ability to read and understand highway signs or his knowledge
17 of the traffic laws of the state.
