6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to zoning in Potter Point State Game
7 Refuge; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.20.030(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) The following described state-owned lands and adjacent state
11 waters, excluding existing and applied-for highway, pipelines and
12 railway rights-of-way as of May 20, 1971, are established as the Potter
13 Point State Game Refuge: All lands and waters south and west of and
14 adjacent to the toe of the bluff which extends from Campbell Point
15 southeasterly to Potter Creek. Notwithstanding any other provision of
16 law, within one year from the effective date of this Act, the munici-
17 pality in which the Potter Point State Game Refuge is contained may
18 zone privately owned land within the refuge. If no zoning action is
19 taken by the municipality within one year, the Department of Natural
20 Resources may adopt, in accordance with the Administrative Procedure
21 Act (AS 44.62), zoning regulations governing privately owned land within
22 the Potter Point State Game Refuge.

23 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
24 070(c).
