6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the appointment and compensation of
7 public administrators; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 22.15.310 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 22.15.310. APPOINTMENT. When authorized by the supreme court,
12 the presiding judge [OF THE DISTRICT COURT] in each judicial district
13 shall appoint a person to act as public administrator of the estate
14 [ESTATES] of a deceased person [PERSONS] and as coroner.

15 * Sec. 2. AS 22.15.340 is amended to read:

16 Sec. 22.15.340. COMPENSATION. A public administrator is entitled
17 to reasonable [ANNUAL] compensation in an amount to be determined by the
18 supreme court, and he is not entitled to fees as other administrators.

19 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect upon the effective date of a bill relating
20 to inquiries into death and establishing the office of state medical examiner.
