For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating for shortfalls in revenue and
7 for extraordinary expenditures of boroughs, cities,
8 municipal utility systems and school districts to meet
9 the effects of the natural disaster of November 14,
10 1974; and providing for an effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. The sum of \$380,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
13 meet shortfalls in revenue and for the payment of extraordinary expenses
14 incurred by boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and school districts
15 in the area declared as a natural disaster area by President Ford's proclama-
16 tion of November 14, 1974.

* Sec. 2. This sum is available to meet shortfalls in revenue and to pay
18 extraordinary expenses of boroughs, cities, municipal utility systems and
19 school districts brought on directly by the natural disaster, provided that
20 extraordinary expenses otherwise compensated for may not be compensated for
21 under this Act.

* Sec. 3. This sum shall be available until June 30, 1976 and shall be
23 distributed as follows:

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
