6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to temporary licenses and certifi-
7 cates."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.01 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 08.01.065. TEMPORARY LICENSES. The commissioner of commerce
11 may issue temporary licenses or certificates when a board which has the
12 duty to issue a license or certificate is unable to function because of
13 the lack of a quorum due to vacancies on the board. A certificate or
14 license issued under this section is valid for a period to be determined
15 by the commissioner but not in excess of 90 days. It may be renewed
16 for successive periods not in excess of 90 days if the conditions re-
17 quired for issuance under this section continue to exist. Certificates
18 or licenses issued under this section expire upon the board resuming its
19 licensing function.
