6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the annual motor vehicle license
7 tax; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.10.200(b)(9) is amended to read:

10 (9) for a vehicle registration fee under (2) or (8) of this
11 subsection, a registrant who is 65 years old or older and has been a
12 resident for at least 10 consecutive years may register one vehicle a
13 year at a cost of \$5 and a disabled veteran receiving at least 70 per
14 cent disability compensation may register one vehicle a year without
15 charge;

16 * Sec. 2. AS 28.10.650 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

17 (22) "resident" means a person who maintains his domicile in
18 the state: domicile is the true and permanent home of a person from which
19 he has no present intention of removing and to which he intends to return
20 whenever he is away.

21 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 1976.
