6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the possession of weapons by
7 convicts."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.55.030 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 11.55.030. POSSESSION BY CONVICTS. A person who has been
11 convicted of a felony, or [A MISDEMEANOR INVOLVING ASSAULT AND BATTERY,]
12 assault with a dangerous weapon, burglary, robbery and like crimes, by a
13 court in the state, or by the courts of the United States or of another
14 state or territory, may not own or have in his possession or under his
15 custody or control a pistol, revolver, or other firearm capable of being
16 concealed about his person, or carry concealed about his person a knife
17 with a blade over two inches long or a dirk or dagger, slingshot, metal
18 knuckles, or an instrument by the use of which injury could be inflicted
19 upon the person or property of another.
