6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the possession of weapons by
7 convicts."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 11.55.030 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 11.55.030. POSSESSION BY CONVICTS. (a) A person who has
11 been convicted of a felony, or [A MISDEMEANOR INVOLVING ASSAULT AND
12 BATTERY,] assault with a dangerous weapon, burglary, robbery and like
13 crimes, by a court in this [THE] state, or by the courts of the United
14 States or of another state or territory, may not own or have in his
15 possession or under his custody or control a pistol, revolver, or other
16 firearm capable of being concealed about his person, or carry concealed
17 about his person a knife with a blade over two inches long or a dirk or
18 dagger, slingshot, metal knuckles, or an instrument commonly considered
19 to be a weapon [BY THE USE OF WHICH INJURY COULD BE INFLICTED UPON THE
20 PERSON OR PROPERTY OF ANOTHER].

21 (b) The provisions of (a) of this section do not apply to a person
22 who has received a pardon for the prior conviction upon which this
23 action is based or, in the case of a felony, when the final termination
24 of the sentence, including any probationary period, was more than 10
25 years before the time of ownership, possession or control of a weapon as
26 specified in (a) of this section.
