6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to bribery."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 11.30.040 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 11.30.040. BRIBERY. A person who corruptly gives, offers, or  
10 promises to give a gift, gratuity, valuable consideration or other thing,  
11 or corruptly promises to do or causes to be done an act beneficial to a  
12 judicial or executive officer, or peace officer as defined in AS 01.10.-  
13 060(6), with intent to influence the vote, opinion, decision, judgment,  
14 or official conduct of the officer in a matter, question, duty, cause, or  
15 proceeding which is or by law may come or be brought before him, or with  
16 intent to influence the officer to act in his official capacity in a  
17 particular manner to produce or prevent a particular result, upon con-  
18 viction, is punishable by imprisonment [IN THE PENITENTIARY] for not less  
19 than two years nor more than 10 years.

21 Sec. 11.30.050. ACCEPTING BRIBE. A judicial or executive officer,  
22 or police officer as defined in AS 01.10.060(6), who corruptly accepts  
23 or receives a gift, gratuity, valuable consideration, or thing, or a  
24 promise of one of them, or a promise to do or cause to be done an act  
25 beneficial to him, with the understanding or agreement, express or  
26 implied, that the officer will give his vote, opinion, decision, or judg-  
27 ment in a particular manner in a matter, question, duty, cause, or pro-  
28 ceeding which then is or may by law come or be brought before him, or  
29 with the understanding or agreement that the officer will in his official

1 capacity act in a particular manner to produce or prevent a particular  
2 result, upon conviction, is punishable by imprisonment [IN THE PENITEN-  
3 TIARY] for not less than five years nor more than 15 years.
