6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the state Board of Education; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.07.085(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) One member shall be appointed from each of the four judicial  
11 districts and three from the state at large with at least one member  
12 representing state-operated rural schools and one member from among a  
13 list of no more than three nominees who are inhabitants of military  
14 reservations in the state submitted by the senior military commander  
15 in Alaska.

16 \* Sec. 2. The first vacancy that occurs among the members of the state  
17 Board of Education who do not represent one of the judicial districts or the  
18 state-operated rural schools shall be filled by an individual selected from  
19 among the list of nominees submitted by the senior military commander in  
20 Alaska.

21 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-  
22 070(c).
