6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to daylight savings time; and pro-
7 viding for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 14. GENERAL PROVISIONS.

11 Sec. 44.14.010. EXEMPTION FROM DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME. (a) Under
12 the authority granted under 15 U.S.C. 260(a)(2), the state is exempted
13 from the provisions of 15 U.S.C. 260(a) providing for the advancement
14 of time of one hour beginning at two o'clock antemeridian on the last
15 Sunday of April of each year and ending at two o'clock antemeridian on
16 the last Sunday of October of each year.

17 (b) The Department of Commerce shall adopt regulations necessary
18 to implement the provisions of (a) of this section.

19 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
20 070(c).
