6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting persons from being on a highway  
7 while under the influence of liquor or other drugs."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 28.35.145. UNLAWFUL PRESENCE ON HIGHWAY BY PERSONS UNDER THE  
11 INFLUENCE. (a) a person may not be upon a highway, so as to be a  
12 hazard to the motoring public, while under the influence of intoxicating  
13 liquor, depressant, hallucinogenic or stimulant drugs or narcotic drugs  
14 as defined in AS 17.10.230(13) and AS 17.12.150(3).

15 (b) As used in this section, "highway" includes only the traveled  
16 portion of a highway open to vehicular traffic.
