6 For an Act entitled: "An Act prohibiting persons from being on a highway  
7 while under the influence of liquor or other drugs."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 28.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 28.35.145. UNLAWFUL PRESENCE ON HIGHWAY. (a) A person may  
11 not be upon a highway, so as to be a hazard to the motoring public.

12 (b) As used in this section, "highway" includes only the traveled  
13 portion of a highway open to vehicular traffic.

14 (c) As used in this section, "hazard" means that the presence of  
15 the person on the highway creates a clear and present danger of harm to  
16 himself or others.
