6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to eligibility for limited entry
7 permits."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.43.250 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

10 (d) The commission shall establish a 40-point system to determine
11 eligibility for the issuance of entry permits based on (1) - (2) of this
12 section. In addition to points awarded for other reasons, at least one
13 point shall be awarded to a person for each year he held a commercial
14 fishing license before January 1, 1973.

15 (e) In determining the degree of hardship that an applicant would
16 suffer by exclusion from the fishery, the commission shall give as much
17 consideration to the extent of his past participation as a commercial
18 fishing license holder as to his past participation as a gear license
19 holder, for any year between January 1, 1960 and January 1, 1973 if it
20 finds that a low run of fish resulted in a significantly below average
21 return for that fishery for that year.
