6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the crime of malicious or wanton  
7 injury to animals or other personality."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 11.20.520 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 11.20.520. MALICIOUS OR WANTON INJURY TO ANIMALS OR OTHER  
11 PERSONALITY. A person who maliciously or wantonly kills, wounds, dis-  
12 figures, or injures any animal the property of another, or wilfully  
13 administers poison to the animal, or maliciously exposes poison with  
14 intent that it be taken by the animal, or who maliciously or wantonly,  
15 by means not specified in this chapter, destroys or injures personal  
16 property of another is guilty of malicious or wanton injury to person-  
17 ality, and upon conviction, if the animal or other property exceeds  
18 \$500 in value is punishable by imprisonment for not less than six months  
19 nor more than three years, or by a fine of not less than \$50 nor more  
20 than \$1,000. If the animal or other property does not exceed \$500 in  
21 value, a person upon conviction, is punishable by imprisonment for not  
22 less than one month nor more than one year, or by a fine of not less than  
23 \$25 nor more than \$500 [ , UPON CONVICTION, IS PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT  
24 IN THE PENITENTIARY FOR NOT LESS THAN SIX MONTHS NOR MORE THAN THREE  
25 YEARS, OR BY IMPRISONMENT IN A JAIL FOR NOT LESS THAN THREE MONTHS NOR  
26 MORE THAN ONE YEAR, OR BY A FINE OF NOT LESS THAN \$50 NOR MORE THAN  
27 \$1,000].
