6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to population limitations on issuance
7 of new liquor licenses; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 04.10.210 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 04.10.210. POPULATION LIMITATIONS ON ISSUANCE OF NEW LICENSE.

12 (a) Unless otherwise provided, no application for a new license shall be
13 approved for any location

14 (1) outside an incorporated city or organized borough where
15 the total of licensed premises in the aggregate at one time would exceed
16 one license of each type for each 1,500 population or fraction thereof
17 within a radius of five miles of the proposed location;

18 (2) within an incorporated city, organized borough area out-
19 side the boundaries of a city, or area of a former city within a unified
20 municipality organized under AS 29.68.240 - 29.68.440, where the total
21 of licensed premises in the aggregate at one time would exceed one
22 license of each type for each 1,500 population or fraction thereof with-
23 in the city or other area designated in this paragraph.

24 (b) In (a)(1) and (2) of this section

25 (1) "incorporated city" means a home rule or general law city;

26 (2) "organized borough" means a home rule or general law
27 borough and includes but is not limited to a unified municipality organ-
28 ized under AS 29.68.240 - 29.68.440;

29 (3) "organized borough area outside the boundaries of a city"

1 means the area of a home rule or general law borough located outside a
2 city within the borough and includes but is not limited to the area of a
3 unified municipality organized under AS 29.68.240 - 29.68.440 located
4 outside a former city of the unified municipality.

5 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
6 070(c).
