5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to eligibility for veterans' loans."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. It is the intent of the legislature to grant service
9 eligibility to LaVerne C. Dunham for a veteran's loan under AS 26.15.130(a)
10 (3) because it now appears that the honorable discharge given on March 1,
11 1964 to then PFC E3 Dunham, 292245909, from the Alaska Army National Guard,
12 BG 3d Bn 297 Inf, Anchorage, Alaska, was issued at that time as the result
13 of a misunderstanding over missed drills when Private Dunham had served
14 only four years, two months and 24 days of his six-year enlistment.

15 * Sec. 2. In recognition of the fact that Private Dunham built a stone
16 foundation for the armory signboard during the disputed drill periods, and
17 served the remaining one year, nine months and six days of his military
18 obligation period in the United States Army Reserves, the commissioner of
19 the Alaska Department of Commerce and the director of the Division of
20 Veterans' Affairs shall consider for the purposes of AS 26.15.130(a)(3)
21 that LaVerne C. Dunham has served six years in the Alaska Army National
22 Guard.

23 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
