6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to occupational licensing."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 08.01 is amended by adding a new section to read:

9 Sec. 08.01.025. PUBLIC MEMBERS. No public member of a board may:

10 (1) be engaged in the occupation which the board regulates;

11 (2) be associated by legal contract with a member of the
12 occupation which the board regulates except as a consumer of the ser-
13 vices provided by a practitioner of the occupation; or

14 (3) have a direct financial interest in the occupation which
15 the board regulates.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 08.04.020 is amended to read:

17 Sec. 08.04.020. APPOINTMENT AND QUALIFICATIONS OF BOARD. The
18 board consists of seven [FIVE] members appointed by the governor. Each
19 member shall be [A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES AND] a resident of this
20 state for at least one year. Three [AT LEAST THREE] members shall be
21 certified public accountants, two members shall be public members in
22 accordance with AS 08.01.025, and the remaining members shall be public
23 accountants. Except for public members, no [NO] one may be appointed
24 who does not hold a current certificate or license issued under the
25 laws of this state. Except for public members, no [NO] one may be
26 appointed who is not eligible to receive permits under this chapter.

27 * Sec. 3. AS 08.24.011 is amended to read:

28 Sec. 08.24.011. COLLECTION AGENCY BOARD. There is created a
29 Collection Agency Board consisting of five [THREE] members, four [TWO]

1 of whom shall be appointed by the governor. The board shall consist
2 of two persons engaged in the collection agency business within the
3 state and licensed under this chapter. The third member shall be design-
4 nated by the commissioner of commerce and economic development from
5 his staff. Two members shall be public members in accordance with
6 AS 08.01.025.

7 * Sec. 4. AS 08.62.010 is amended to read:

8 Sec. 08.62.010. CREATION AND MEMBERSHIP OF BOARD. There is
9 created the Board of Marine Pilots. It consists of two pilots licensed
10 under this chapter who have been actively engaged in piloting on
11 vessels subject to this chapter, two agents or managers of vessels
12 subject to this chapter, two public members in accordance with AS 08.-
13 01.025, and the commissioner or his designee. Not more than one pilot
14 and one agent or manager shall be from any one judicial district. All
15 members of the board shall be residents of the state.

16 * Sec. 5. AS 08.88.011 is amended to read:

17 Sec. 08.88.011. CREATION AND MEMBERSHIP OF COMMISSION. There is
18 created a Real Estate Commission. It consists of seven [FIVE] members.

19 * Sec. 6. AS 08.88.041(a) is amended to read:

20 (a) Five members of the commission must be real estate brokers
21 or associate brokers who have been licensed real estate brokers or
22 licensed associate brokers in Alaska for at least three years before
23 appointment. Two members of the board must be public members in accor-
24 dance with AS 08.01.025 [TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR APPOINTMENT AS A MEMBER OF
25 THE COMMISSION A PERSON MUST BE A REAL ESTATE BROKER OR ASSOCIATE BROKER
26 WHO HAS BEEN A LICENSED REAL ESTATE BROKER OR A LICENSED ASSOCIATE
27 BROKER IN ALASKA FOR AT LEAST THREE YEARS BEFORE HIS APPOINTMENT].

29 (b) At least two judicial districts shall be represented and at
