4 NINTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing production of audio-visual educa-  
7 tional materials about Alaska state government."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. This Act authorizes and directs the division of state  
10 libraries and museums of the Department of Education to prepare educational  
11 audio-visual materials about the Alaska state government suitable for class-  
12 room use in secondary schools and colleges, suitable for use by civic groups,  
13 and suitable for broadcast by public and commercial television stations. The  
14 power and authority necessary to accomplish this project is granted to the  
15 division.

16 \* Sec. 2. Separate productions will be made covering each of the three  
17 branches of government (executive, legislative and judicial). Production  
18 may be in successive years beginning with the production on the legislature  
19 first, followed by the production on the judiciary and the executive.

20 \* Sec. 3. (a) An advisory committee from each branch of government will  
21 assist the division to assure the accuracy of the productions.

22 (b) The judicial council will act as the advisory committee for the  
23 production on the judiciary.

24 (c) The legislative council will act as the advisory committee for the  
25 production on the legislature.

26 (d) The advisory committee for the executive branch production will be  
27 composed of from three to five members appointed by the governor, including  
28 one member of the governor's staff, one commissioner, and one supervisory  
29 member of the career service who has been employed by the state 10 years or

1 more.

2 \* Sec. 4. The production on the legislature may not be made public before  
3 November 15, 1976, and the production about the executive branch may not be  
4 made public before November 15, 1978.

5 \* Sec. 5. Partisan political use of photographs, films, video or audio  
6 tapes developed as part of any of the productions covered in this Act is  
7 prohibited. A person who violates or aids a person in violation of this  
8 prohibition is guilty of a misdemeanor.
