6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the University of Alaska; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 14.40.055. SENIOR CITIZEN EXEMPTION FROM TUITION AND FEES.

11 Persons who are and have been residents of the state for five consecu-
12 tive years, who are 60 years of age or older, and who apply for enroll-
13 ment or who are enrolled in the university are exempt from tuition or
14 fees imposed by the university for educational or educationally related
15 services. This exemption does not (1) apply to charges for room and
16 board or other student activities unrelated to educational or educa-
17 tionally related services and (2) guarantee a person qualifying for the
18 exemption a place in any course offered by the university; registration
19 in a course is on a space-available basis only.

20 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1975.
