5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the compensation of judicial
7 officers, legislators, and public officers; and
8 legislative per diem; and providing for an effective
9 date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 22.05.140(a) is amended to read:

12 (a) The annual salary for the chief justice and each associate
13 justice is 20 per cent above Step E, Range 28 of the salary schedule
14 established in AS 39.27.010 for Anchorage, Alaska [SHALL RECEIVE \$44,000
15 ANNUALLY AS COMPENSATION]. The compensation is payable monthly in 12
16 equal installments. Compensation of the chief justice or of an associate
17 justice shall not be diminished during his term of office, unless by
18 general law applying to all salaried officers of the state.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 22.10.190(a) is amended to read:

20 (a) The annual salary for each [EACH] superior court judge is 10
21 per cent above Step E, Range 28 of the salary schedule established in
22 AS 39.27.010 for Anchorage, Alaska [SHALL RECEIVE \$40,000 ANNUALLY, AS
23 COMPENSATION], payable monthly in 12 equal installments. The compensa-
24 tion of a judge shall not be diminished during his term of office, unless
25 by general law applying to all salaried officers of the state.

26 * Sec. 3. AS 22.15.220(a) is amended to read:

27 (a) The annual salary for each [EACH] district judge is 93 per
28 cent of Step E, Range 28 of the salary schedule established in AS 39.-
29 27.010 for Anchorage, Alaska [SHALL RECEIVE \$33,500 ANNUALLY AS COMPEN-

1 SATION], payable monthly in 12 equal installments.

2 * Sec. 4. AS 24.15.020 is amended to read:

3 Sec. 24.15.020. ANNUAL LEGISLATIVE SALARIES. The annual salary
4 for each member of the legislature is 33-1/3 per cent of Step E, Range
5 28 of the salary schedule established in AS 39.27.010 for Anchorage,
6 Alaska, [\$9,000] to be paid in approximately equal monthly payments.
7 The president of the senate and speaker of the house are each entitled
8 to an additional \$500 a year during tenure of office.

9 * Sec. 5. AS 39.20.010 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 39.20.010. ANNUAL SALARY OF GOVERNOR. The annual salary of
11 the governor is 30 per cent above Step E, Range 28 of the salary
12 schedule established in AS 39.27.010 for Anchorage, Alaska [\$50,000].
13 The salary shall be paid in equal monthly installments.

14 * Sec. 6. AS 39.20.030 is amended to read:

15 Sec. 39.20.030. ANNUAL SALARY OF LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR. The annual
16 salary of the lieutenant governor is 20 per cent above Step E, Range 28
17 of the salary schedule established in AS 39.27.010 for Anchorage,
18 Alaska [\$44,000]. The salary shall be paid in equal monthly install-
19 ments.

20 * Sec. 7. AS 39.20.080(a) is amended to read:

21 (a) The annual salary of the head of each principal executive
22 department of the state upon appointment and confirmation is 10 per cent
23 above Step E, Range 28 of the salary schedule established in AS 39.27.-
24 010 for Anchorage, Alaska [\$40,000]. This salary shall be paid in equal
25 monthly installments.

26 * Sec. 8. AS 24.15.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

27 Sec. 24.15.010. LEGISLATIVE PER DIEM. (a) For each day of the
28 legislative session and for each day on official legislative business
29 between sessions, legislators (1) on travel status and away from home

overnight shall be allowed, instead of their actual expenses for subsistence a per diem allowance of \$40 for each day; (2) not away from home overnight shall receive an allowance of \$25 for each day. The per diem allowance is also payable for each day of necessary travel.
