6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to providing major medical insurance
7 to persons receiving benefits from the Teachers' and
8 Public Employees' Retirement System; and providing for
9 an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 14.25.168 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

12 Sec. 14.25.168. MEDICAL BENEFITS. Each person who is entitled to
13 receive a monthly benefit from the retirement system shall be provided
14 with major medical insurance coverage. Coverage shall become effective
15 on the same date as retirement benefits commence and cease when the
16 retired employee or survivor is no longer eligible to receive a monthly
17 benefit. The level of coverage for persons over age 65 shall be the
18 same as that available prior to reaching age 65 except that the benefits
19 payable shall be supplemental to those afforded under the federal Old
20 Age Survivor and Disability Insurance Program, if any.

21 * Sec. 2. AS 39.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

22 Sec. 39.35.535. MEDICAL BENEFITS. Each person who is entitled to
23 receive a monthly benefit from the retirement system shall be provided
24 with major medical insurance coverage. Coverage shall become effective
25 on the same date as retirement benefits commence and cease when the
26 retired employee or survivor is no longer eligible to receive a monthly
27 benefit. The level of coverage for persons over age 65 shall be the same
28 as that available prior to reaching age 65 except that the benefits
29 payable shall be supplemental to those afforded under the federal Old

1 Age Survivor and Disability Insurance Program, if any.

2 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1975.
