6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the waste of wild food animals; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 16.30.010(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A person who intentionally kills a wild food animal and does  
11 not make a reasonable effort to salvage most of its edible meat for  
12 human consumption, is guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is  
13 punishable by a fine of not more than \$500, or by imprisonment for not  
14 more than six months, or by both. In addition and notwithstanding  
15 AS 16.05.410, upon conviction of a violation of this section, the court  
16 shall revoke the violator's hunting license for a period of five years.  
17 A person whose license has been revoked under this subsection may not  
18 purchase another license of the same type for a period of five years.
