6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to registration of voters; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 15.07.130(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) When a registered voter has not voted in either a primary
11 or general election at least once in two [FOUR] consecutive calendar
12 years, the voter shall be advised by mail sent to his last known address
13 that his registration will be cancelled unless he indicates within 90
14 days on forms furnished by the lieutenant governor his desire to remain
15 registered. If an election board in a precinct does not receive the
16 required election materials under AS 15.15.050 to enable the board to
17 conduct the election and the registered voters in that precinct to cast
18 their ballots either in person or by absentee ballot, that primary or
19 general election may not be counted as one in which a registered voter
20 has failed to vote.

21 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
22 070(c).
