6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to penalties for game violations; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.435. REVOCATION OF HUNTING LICENSE. Notwithstanding
11 AS 16.05.410 and in addition to other penalties provided by law, upon
12 conviction of a violation of a big game statute or regulation, the
13 license of the violator shall be revoked for not less than one year.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 08.54.200(c)(3) is amended to read:

15 (3) has been convicted of a violation [TWO VIOLATIONS] of
16 federal or state sport fish, game or guide statutes or regulations. In
17 the case of a conviction for a violation of a big game statute or regula-
18 tion the period of revocation shall be for not less than one year.

19 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
20 070(c).
