8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 09.25.110 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 09.25.110. INSPECTION AND COPIES OF PUBLIC RECORDS. Unless  
11 specifically provided otherwise the books, records, papers, files,  
12 accounts, writings, and transactions of all agencies and departments are  
13 public records and are open to inspection by the public under reasonable  
14 rules during regular office hours. Complaint records of any police  
15 department and the Department of Public Safety except reports or com-  
16 plaints submitted to the state and local police in confidence are public  
17 records under this section. The public officer having the custody of  
18 public records shall give on request and payment of costs a certified  
19 copy of the public record.
