6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the crime of bribery."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 11.30.040 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 11.30.040. BRIBERY. A person who corruptly gives, offers,
10 or promises to give a gift, gratuity, valuable consideration or other
11 thing, or corruptly promises to do or causes to be done an act bene-
12 ficial to a public servant [JUDICIAL OR EXECUTIVE OFFICER], with intent
13 to influence the vote, opinion, decision, judgment, or official conduct
14 of the public servant [OFFICER] in a matter, question, duty, cause, or
15 proceeding which is or by law may come or be brought before him, or with
16 intent to influence the public servant [OFFICER] to act in his official
17 capacity in a particular manner to produce or prevent a particular
18 result, upon conviction, is punishable by imprisonment [IN THE PENI-
19 TENTIARY] for not less than two years nor more than 10 years.

20 * Sec. 2. AS 11.30.050 is amended to read:

21 Sec. 11.30.050. ACCEPTING BRIBE. A public servant [JUDICIAL OR
22 EXECUTIVE OFFICER] who corruptly accepts or receives a gift, gratuity,
23 valuable consideration, or thing, or a promise of one of them, or a
24 promise to do or cause to be done an act beneficial to him, with the
25 understanding or agreement, express or implied, that the public servant
26 [OFFICER] will give his vote, opinion, decision, or judgment in a par-
27 ticular manner in a matter, question, duty, cause, or proceeding which
28 then is or may by law come or be brought before him, or with the under-
29 standing or agreement that the public servant [OFFICER] will in his

1 official capacity act in a particular manner to produce or prevent a
2 particular result, upon conviction, is punishable by imprisonment [IN
3 THE PENITENTIARY] for not less than five years nor more than 15 years.

4 * Sec. 3. AS 11.30 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 Sec. 11.30.055. PUBLIC SERVANT DEFINED. For purposes of secs.
6 40 - 50 of this chapter, "public servant" means an officer, member or
7 employee of the legislative, executive, or judicial branches of govern-
8 ment or of a municipality or governmental entity of the state, including
9 a board or commission, or a juror or prospective juror from the time he
10 is summoned, referee, arbitrator, hearing officer, or other person
11 authorized by law to hear or determine a question or controversy.
