6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to municipal revenue sharing; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 43.18.040 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 43.18.040. REGULATIONS. The Department of Community and
11 Regional Affairs shall adopt regulations necessary to carry out the
12 purposes of secs. 10 - 99 of this chapter. The regulations shall include
13 minimum standards required to qualify a municipality for grants for each
14 service and provisions for a performance report adequate to demonstrate
15 to the department that each service for which credit was allowed was
16 actually performed by the municipality, at least at the prescribed
17 minimum level.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 43.18.020(b) is amended to read:

19 (b) The special municipal services account is established. Funds
20 to carry out the provisions of sec. 10 of this chapter may be appropri-
21 ated annually by the legislature to the account. If amounts in the
22 account are insufficient for the purpose of each local government's
23 or other recipient's share authorized under sec. 10 of this chapter,
24 such funds as are available shall be distributed pro rata among eligible
25 local governments and other recipients.

26 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1976.
