6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to particularization of persons en-
7 titled to service credit for service rendered to
8 Alaska before statehood; and providing for an effec-
9 tive date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 39.35.360(a) is amended to read:

12 (a) An employee who completes three years of service with the state
13 after January 1, 1961, for which he makes contributions required by this
14 chapter is entitled to service credit for employment rendered to the
15 State and former Territory of Alaska before January 1, 1961, regardless
16 of the office, department, division, or agency of the state or territory
17 in which he was employed, including service as a commissioned officer of
18 the United States Public Health Service, the United States District
19 Court and the United States Commissioner's Court serving the Territory
20 and State of Alaska succeeded to by the Alaska court system, [AND]
21 persons employed as United States marshals, United States deputy marshals,
22 [AND] Civil Aeronautics Administration security guards, policemen or
23 firemen of the territory or a political subdivision of the territory,
24 and employees of the Alaska Road Commission and Bureau of Public Roads.
25 The retirement benefits payable to an employee under this section which
26 are attributable to employment rendered to the State and former Territory
27 of Alaska before January 1, 1961, shall be reduced by the amount of the
28 retirement pension benefits paid to him by the United States government
29 for the same period of prior service.

1 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
2 070(c).
