6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the exclusion of areas from a
7 municipality."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 29.68.101(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) In addition to the regulations governing annexation by local
11 action adopted under AS 44.19.260, the Local Boundary Commission
12 shall, within 90 days of September 10, 1972, establish procedures for
13 annexation and exclusion of territory by cities and boroughs by local
14 action. The procedures established under this subsection shall include

15 (1) a provision requiring that a proposed annexation [AND
16 EXCLUSION] must be approved by a majority of the voters voting on the
17 question residing within the area proposed to be annexed [OR EXCLUDED];

18 (2) provisions that municipally-owned property adjoining the
19 municipality may be annexed by ordinance without voter approval; [AND]

20 (3) provisions that an area adjoining the municipality may
21 be annexed by ordinance without an election if all property owners and
22 voters within the area petition the assembly or council; and

23 (4) a provision requiring that a proposed exclusion must
24 be approved by separate majority votes of the voters in the area to
25 be excluded and of the voters in the area which would remain under
26 the jurisdiction of the existing local government if the exclusion
27 were approved.
