6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to unauthorized parking on state  
7 property."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 35 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

10 CHAPTER 23. UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLES ON STATE PROPERTY.

11 Sec. 35.23.010. AUTHORIZATION FOR THE USE OF PARKING SPACES IN  
12 STATE PARKING AREAS REQUIRED. Without authorization from the Depart-  
13 ment of Administration, no person may park or leave standing a vehicle  
14 in a state-owned or state-managed parking area, except in parking  
15 spaces reserved for the use of the general public and posted as  
16 reserved for that use.

17 Sec. 35.23.020. UNAUTHORIZED VEHICLES MAY BE TICKETED OR IM-  
18 POUNDED. The manager of the state-owned or state-managed property or  
19 a person designated for this purpose by the Department of Admini-  
20 stration may request that state or municipal police come onto that  
21 property for the purpose of ticketing or impounding a vehicle parked  
22 or left standing without proper authorization. Release of the vehicle  
23 to its owner may be accomplished under appropriate municipal or state  
24 procedures which may provide that the costs of ticketing or impound-  
25 ment be paid before the vehicle is returned to its owner.
