5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to Native arts and programs of compe-
7 tition."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 45.65.080 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 45.65.080. PROGRAM OF COMPETITIONS. (a) The department
11 [DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING] shall direct a con-
12 tinuing program of competitions [. THE COMPETITIONS SHALL BE HELD EACH
13 SUMMER] to select outstanding examples of Alaskan Native arts and crafts.

14 (b) The department [DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND PLAN-
15 NING], after consulting with the Institute of Alaskan Native Arts
16 Committee [A COMMITTEE FROM THE ALASKA NATIVE BROTHERHOOD AND SISTERHOOD
17 APPOINTED BY THEIR COUNCILS FROM AMONG THE MEMBERSHIPS OF THOSE ORGANI-
18 ZATIONS], shall adopt regulations for the competitions, providing for,
19 but not limited to the following:

- 20 (1) eligibility requirements for entrants;
- 21 (2) categories for entry, such as basketwork, wood carving,
22 pottery, stone work, ivory work, painting, etc.;
- 23 (3) criterion for selecting category winners and grand prize
24 winners;
- 25 (4) transportation and display of entries;
- 26 (5) prizes and awards for winning entrants which are re-
27 stricted to ribbons, cups, plaques, etc.;
- 28 (6) preparation of entry forms which
29 (A) give the name and mailing address of the entrant,

1 (B) show that each entry is the work of the entrant,

2 (C) give the minimum price that the entrant will accept
3 for his entry,

4 (D) provide the entrant with the choice of having his
5 entry sold, retained for display by the state, or returned to the
6 entrant, and

7 (E) identify and describe the entry [; AND

8 (7) RESTRICTING THE ENTRANT FROM ENTERING COMPETITIONS IN
9 MORE THAN ONE REGION].

10 * Sec. 2. AS 45.65.100 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 45.65.100. PLACE OF COMPETITION. The department [DEPARTMENT
12 OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING] shall solicit invitations [FROM
13 THE LARGER COMMUNITIES IN EACH OF THE REGIONS] for holding the regional
14 competition. The community [IN EACH REGION] which offers the best
15 facilities and the greatest measure of cooperation for conducting the
16 competition shall be selected as the location of the [REGIONAL] compe-
17 tition.

18 * Sec. 3. AS 45.65.110 is amended to read:

19 Sec. 45.65.110. JUDGES. Judges [AT THE REGIONAL COMPETITIONS]
20 shall be selected by the department [DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT
21 AND PLANNING] and composed of a panel of five, two of whom shall be
22 selected from nominees of the Institute of Alaskan Native Arts Committee
23 [ALASKA NATIVE BROTHERHOOD AND SISTERHOOD] and three of whom shall be
24 selected by the department on the basis of their knowledge and apprecia-
25 tion of Alaskan Native arts and crafts and of art in general.

26 * Sec. 4. AS 45.65.130 is amended to read:

27 Sec. 45.65.130. OTHER DISPLAYS. The department [DEPARTMENT OF
28 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING] may display or authorize the display
29 of entries at places other than the location of the regional competition

Sec. 45.65.140. GRANTS AND ASSISTANCE. The department [DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND PLANNING] may accept grants of money and other assistance from private persons or groups, from political subdivisions of the state, or from others to conduct and promote annual competitions and displays.

* Sec. 6. AS 45.65 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 45.65.170. DEFINITIONS. In secs. 80 - 170 of this chapter, unless the context requires otherwise, "department" means the Department of Education.

* Sec. 7. AS 45.65.090 is repealed.
