6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring emergency telephone facilities in  
7 elevators."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 18.60 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 ARTICLE 10. ELEVATORS.

11 Sec. 18.60.800. EMERGENCY TELEPHONE FACILITIES. (a) An elevator  
12 used to transport people between floors in a building located in this  
13 state shall be equipped with an operative telephone connected to a sta-  
14 tion which is continuously monitored by a physically present individual  
15 24 hours each day.

16 (b) A person who owns or maintains an elevator which is not  
17 equipped with emergency telephone facilities, or who owns a building  
18 in which such an elevator is located, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

19 (c) This section applies to elevators used primarily for the trans-  
20 port of freight if the elevator is enclosed and is also used for the  
21 transport of an operator or other persons, but does not apply to ele-  
22 vators located in single family residences.

23 (d) The Department of Labor shall administer this section.
