6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the regulatory powers of municipi-  
7 palities."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 29.48.035(a)(3) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 (3) vehicle parking not inconsistent with AS 28.01.010;  
11 however, no municipality, whether home rule or otherwise, may impose  
12 liability on the owner-lessor of a motor vehicle when the vehicle is  
13 being permissively used by a lessee and is illegally parked or operated,  
14 if upon notification of violation by the municipality the owner-lessor  
15 forwards the notice of violation by a procedure prescribed by the  
16 appropriate court; the owner-lessor will also enclose with the forwarded  
17 notice a self-addressed, postage prepaid envelope which will be fur-  
18 nished by the municipality;
