6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to participation by political sub-
7 divisions and public organizations in the Public
8 Employees' Retirement System; and providing for
9 an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 39.35.550 is amended to read:

12 Sec. 39.35.550. REQUEST BY POLITICAL SUBDIVISION TO PARTICIPATE
13 AND ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION. A municipality or other political sub-
14 division of the state [WHICH PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR ITS EMPLOYEES UNDER
15 TITLE II OF THE FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ACT] may request to become a
16 participating employer in this system. The request shall be made
17 after adoption of a resolution by the legislative body of the political
18 subdivision and after approval of the resolution by the person required
19 by law to approve the resolution. A certified copy of the resolution
20 shall be filed with the Department of Administration. If the commis-
21 sioner of administration approves the request for participation, the
22 political subdivision is a participating employer.

23 * Sec. 2. AS 39.35.560 is amended to read:

24 Sec. 39.35.560. REQUEST BY PUBLIC ORGANIZATION TO PARTICIPATE
25 AND ADOPTION OF RESOLUTION. A public or quasi-public organization
26 created wholly or partly by, or deriving its powers from, the legislature
27 of the state [, WHICH PROVIDES COVERAGE FOR ITS EMPLOYEES UNDER TITLE
28 II OF THE FEDERAL SOCIAL SECURITY ACT,] may request to become a
29 participating employer in this system. The request shall be made

1 after adoption of a resolution by the governing body of the public
2 organization. A certified copy of the resolution shall be filed with
3 the Department of Administration. If the commissioner of administration
4 approves the request for participation, the public organization is a
5 participating employer.

6 * Sec. 3. This Act is retroactive to January 1, 1976.

7 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
8 10.070(c).
