6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to licensing of physicians and osteo-  
7 paths; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.64.311 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 08.64.311. BIENNIAL LICENSE RENEWAL. Licenses shall be  
11 renewed biennially for those licensees who have complied with the con-  
12 tinuing education requirements established by the board.

13 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.64 is amended by adding new sections to read:

14 Sec. 08.64.331. LIMITS AND CONDITIONS OF PRACTICE. The board may  
15 limit the practice of a licensee by specialty, procedure, or facility,  
16 or may require additional training or education of a licensee upon a  
17 finding that the education, experience, or competence of the licensee  
18 requires the limitation of license or additional training or education.

19 Sec. 08.64.333. INVESTIGATION. The board shall employ investi-  
20 gators and attorneys necessary to fully implement its authority to re-  
21 voke, suspend, limit or otherwise regulate the licenses of physicians  
22 and osteopaths.

23 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-  
24 070(c).
