fish and game licenses."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 16.05.940(14) is amended to read:

(14) "resident" means a person who for 12 consecutive months

11

has maintained a permanent place of abode in the state and who has con-

12

tinually maintained his voting residence in the state; and in the case

13

of a partnership, association, joint stock company, trust, or corpora-

14

tion, "resident" means one that has its main office or headquarters in

15

the state; however, a member of the military service on active duty who

16

is permanently [HAS BEEN] stationed in the state [FOR THE PRECEDING 12

17

CONSECUTIVE MONTHS] is a resident for the purposes of this chapter, and

18

the dependent of a resident member of the military service [, WHO HAS

19

BEEN LIVING IN THE STATE FOR THE PRECEDING YEAR] is a resident for the

20

purposes of this chapter, and a person who is an alien but who for one

21

year has maintained a permanent place of abode in the state is a resi-

22

dent for the purposes of this chapter;
