6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to parties entitled to injunctive
7 relief."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 09.40.230 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 09.40.230. AUTHORIZATION FOR INJUNCTION. When it appears
11 that (1) a party to the action [THE PLAINTIFF] is entitled to the relief
12 demanded, and the relief or any part of it includes restraining the
13 commission or continuance of some act, the commission or continuance of
14 which during the litigation would produce injury to the other party
15 [PLAINTIFF]; or (2) a party to the action [THE DEFENDANT] is doing, or
16 threatens or is about to do, or is procuring or suffering to be done
17 some act in violation of another party's [THE PLAINTIFF'S] rights con-
18 cerning the subject of the action and tending to render the judgment
19 ineffectual; or (3) a party to the action [THE DEFENDANT] threatens or
20 is about to remove or dispose of his property or a part of it with intent
21 to delay or defraud his creditors, an injunction may be allowed to
22 restrain such act, removal, or disposition.
