6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to retirement, disability, and death
7 benefits for certain employees of the Department of
8 Fish and Game; and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 39.35.680(14) is amended to read:

11 (14) "peace officer and fireman" means an employee who is
12 employed full time in the state as a peace officer, chief of police,
13 correctional officer, correctional superintendent, qualified employee
14 of the Department of Fish and Game [FISH AND GAME FIELD BIOLOGIST AND
15 TECHNICIAN], fireman or fire chief;

16 * Sec. 2. AS 39.35.680 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

17 (23) "qualified employee of the Department of Fish and
18 Game" means a full time employee of that department whose duties
19 necessitate, or at any time during employment with that department
20 have necessitated, a significant amount of field work, travel, or
21 exposure to hazardous working conditions, as determined by the commis-
22 sioner of administration in consultation with the commissioner of fish
23 and game, except that other personnel of that department are not
24 excluded by this paragraph from status as an "employee" under (5) of
25 this section;

26 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
27 10.070(c).
