6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to larceny and embezzlement."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 11.20.140 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 11.20.140. LARCENY OF MONEY OR PROPERTY. A person who steals  
10 money, goods, or chattels, or a government note, a bank note, promissory  
11 note, bill of exchange, bond, or other thing in action, or a book of  
12 accounts, order or certificate concerning money or goods due or to  
13 become due or to be delivered, or a deed or writing containing a con-  
14 veyance of land or interest in land, or a bill of sale, or writing con-  
15 taining a conveyance of goods or chattels or interest in them, or any  
16 other valuable contract in force, or a receipt, release, or defeasance,  
17 or a writ, process, or public record, which is the property of another,  
18 is guilty of larceny. Upon conviction, if the property stolen exceeds  
19 \$250 [\$100] in value, a person guilty of larceny is punishable by im-  
20 prisonment in the penitentiary for not less than one nor more than 10  
21 years. If the property stolen does not exceed \$250 [\$100] in value, the  
22 person, upon conviction, is punishable by imprisonment in a jail for not  
23 less than one month nor more than one year, or by a fine of not less than  
24 \$25 nor more than \$100.

26 (1) if the property stolen exceeds \$250 [\$50] in value, by  
27 imprisonment in the penitentiary for not less than one nor more than 10  
28 years;

1 value, by imprisonment in jail for not less than one month nor more than  
2 one year, or by a fine of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100.

4 Sec. 11.20.280. EMBEZZLEMENT BY EMPLOYEE OR SERVANT. An officer,  
5 agent, clerk, employee, or servant who embezzles or fraudulently con-  
6 verts to his own use, or takes or secretes with intent to embezzle or  
7 fraudulently convert to his own use, money, property, or thing of  
8 another which may be the subject of larceny, and which has come into  
9 his possession or is under his care by virtue of his employment is guilty  
10 of embezzlement. If the property embezzled exceeds \$250 [\$100] in  
11 value, a person guilty of embezzlement is punishable by imprisonment in  
12 the penitentiary for not less than one year nor more than ten years.  
13 If the property embezzled does not exceed the value of \$250 [\$100], a  
14 person guilty of embezzlement is punishable by imprisonment in a jail  
15 for not less than one month nor more than one year, or by a fine of  
16 not less than \$25 nor more than \$100.
